

Is home education the best option for my family?

The first step is a self-assessment:

How do I want my child to be educated?
In which environment do I want him to study?
What do I want him to learn?
To what external influences am I willing to subject it?
Does my child have any special needs?

The second step is research:

Search for information on the internet - they must validate that the information offered is from a reliable source.

Read articles and books on the subject - Internet and Amazon have many offers

Contact and visit support groups - highly recommended and healthy

The third step is assessment of the situation in light of new information acquired:

Who will be in charge of teaching? Roles and subjects can be divided among parents.

Does homeschooling adapt to our family/economic reality?
Can I stop working? Search with an "online" budget sheet to assess all household expenses and income and make a decision.

What is the opinion of all members of the family nucleus? Only the views of those contributing to household income are taken into account for the decision and, if applicable, consultation with the child's caregiver.
