

Variants of Home Education

- ❖ The mother or father who does not work outside the home and is responsible for most of the education provided to minors.
- ❖ Both parents work outside the home, at different times, and educational tasks are divided. If they work the same shift, they can find a "carer" for the student and leave the job to them. When they return home or over the weekend, they can work on their chores.
- ❖ Some family members (grandmother, uncles, etc.), are responsible for implementing the educational plan selected by the parents.
Example: women who are heads of household.

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- ❖ Parents unite to form Educational Cooperatives (they are responsible for delivering the material of one or several classes). They could also hire an expert in the subject, but parents make decisions and participate actively in the process.
- ❖ Parents hire a private guardian who is responsible for some of the subjects to be taught. You can decide for this option after having exhausted other options that are cheaper (Internet help searches such as videos, apps), since the cost can be a disadvantage.
- ❖ Parents can hire distance education services from a licensed school.
